SAFETY PROTOCOLS AT A GLANCE

General safety Points

- Face masks mandatory for all students Grade 1 and above
- Additional masks to be brought to school each day
- Face shield recommended for eating
- Regular 20 second hand washing
- You may wish to bring your own disinfectant wipes
- Dedicated entry and exit points for the community
- Regular sanitising and cleaning of school spaces
- Bring your own food and water bottles no sharing
- Designated grade level toilets
- Restricted numbers in shared bathrooms at any one time
- Lockers distanced 1m apart, individually allocated no sharing
- One way traffic flows throughout the school
- Clear signage provided for safety and movement
- 1m distancing at all times
- Observe distancing when queuing for toilets
- All Staff are required to be fully vaccinated OR have a PCR test each week if granted an official medical exemption

Entry and Exit of Students

Students should only come to school if they:

- Are fully registered at Gate 1 for 2021-22
- Have proof of an up to date negative Covid-19 test for **12 years and over on the first day of term**
- Are healthy and showing no symptoms of any illness
- Observe all signage and social distancing on entry
- Enter/exit via the appropriate gate and pass through temperature screening on arrival. Gate 1 is not available to students.
- Parents and other visitors should not come onsite during school hours, except to designated drop off/pick up zone and then only one parent per family.
- If parents or students are coming after school, they should make an appointment in advance.

The COVID-19 Taskforce will continue to oversee the guidelines and protocols

Entry and Exit Points

We will be using the following entry and exit points across the school:

- Gate 1- Administration, Registration and Finance Offices Parents only (No student entry or exit)
- Gate 2- Secondary school rear entrance Secondary School only
- Gate 3- Primary School Primary School only
- Gate 4- Early Learning Centre ELC students and their siblings entry only
- Gate 5- Community Centre Primary School and Secondary School (preferably siblings only)

All the gates will be manned by security and students will be directed to pass through temperature testing stations at each entrance as per below:

- Gate 1 Reception area (Not available to students)
- Gate 2 Innovation Centre
- Gate 3 Primary School Office
- Gate 4 Early Learning Centre Office
- Gate 5 Community Centre:
 - Primary students go through the Primary School Gym
 - $\circ~$ Secondary students go in by the pool and through the Main Gym



As per each academic year, the local authorities and VISS security will be supporting our community to ensure our students are enter and exit school safely.

Please remember to adhere to all road rules as you drop off your children, make sure that your children are safe as they enter and exit your vehicles, and ensure you park in designated car parks.

Dear Parents

As you will know from our previous letter, we are very much looking forward to welcoming Secondary students back to school onsite on Sunday. Please remember that students need to be registered for 2021/22 and those 12+ on the first day of term have provided proof of a negative COVID test from 72 hours before their first day onsite (information on how to do this will come seperately on Thursday).

Students will need to bring their books, a fully charged iPad(G6-0) or laptop (G10-12) - stationary will be provided. They will also need to bring two masks and their food and drink for the day (we are hoping to transition back the canteen this term, but this will not happen for a while)

Each student boarding the bus will have their temperature taken at the door by the conductor If the temperature is higher than 37.5C they will **NOT** be permitted to board the bus




Sanitiser will be available on all buses
